-SYNOPSIS-

Narrators welcome us to the Hundred Acre Wood and introduce us to Christopher Robin's friends. When Pooh's Tummy rumbles, he realizes that he doesn't have any honey for his snack and starts his search for honey. Pooh decides to get honey from his best friend. Christopher Robin is not at home but has left a note for Pooh. Pooh shows the note to Piglet, who suggests they take the note to Rabbit. His hunger increasing, Pooh asks Rabbit for an extra stash of honey as a swarm of Bees eavesdrop. Rabbit is terrified by the note and tells Pooh and Piglet to take it to Owl for a full explanation. After examining the note, Owl reports that Christopher Robin has been captured by a creature named The Backson!

Pooh and Piglet hatch a plan to make a pit that will trap the Backson, and disguise the pit to look like a picnic to lure the Backson. The plan works so well that Rabbit tries to grab some food and falls into the pit, followed by many other woodland creatures. Pooh and Piglet hear noise coming from their Backson trap and find all of their friends piled in the pit, but still no Backson. Pooh tries to think of a new plan to rescue his friends and remembers a song that Christopher Robin used to sing to him.

The animals are relieved when they see Christopher Robin on his way home! He explains that his note stated he was busy and would be "back soon." All is cleared up, and the friends decide to have a picnic to celebrate. Pooh invites the Bees to the picnic, and they bring enough honey for everyone.

This show was a product of STAAR Theatre's Musical Theatre Production Class. The Actors are comprised of children ages 5-12, and the Creatives are teenagers aged 13-17. While Actors learned stage terminology, warm-ups, acting skills, and choreography, the Creatives attended a series of workshops for different theatrical departments. Workshop Mentors were past and current STAAR Theatre production team members. The Creatives then split into crews to focus on designing and bringing to life the character looks, the set decorations, the lighting and sound.
